Care & Maintenance

Healthcare Fabrics require regular care & maintenance. If the recommended instructions are followed, the end user can expect to maximise the fabrics potential life and maintain a hygienic environment.

General Cleaning

Regularly clean **Ultra-Tick** Healthcare Fabrics with a mild solution of phenolic based cleaner and water. Rinse thoroughly with fresh water and wipe dry.

Spot Cleaning

For difficult spills and stains, prepare a strong solution of phenolic based commercial cleaner. Using a soft bristle brush and solution, clean the affected area. Rinse thoroughly with fresh water and wipe dry.

Disinfection

It is common to disinfect surfaces in a healthcare environment. Using a water/bleach solution of 10:1, clean the entire mattress. The bleach must not have a sodium hypochlorite level in excess of 5%. Disinfectants applied at full concentration will decrease the life of **Ultra-Tick** Healthcare Fabrics. Rinse thoroughly with fresh water and wipe dry.

Notes

- Never exceed the cleaning manufacturers concentration recommendations.
- Do not use abrasive cloths or cleaners.
- Do not use aggressive cleaners or chemicals.
- Ultra-Tick Healthcare Fabrics are not autoclavable.
